

Exercise Key-Continuous Form of Tense

1) The children were laughing at a joke.

Neg: The children were not laughing at a joke.

Que: Were the children laughing at a joke?

2) She will be going shopping this weekend.

Neg: She will not be going shopping this weekend.

Que: Will she be going shopping this weekend?

3) John will be working on his presentation.

Neg: John will not be working on his presentation.

Que: Will John be working on his presentation?

4) She is wearing a dress.

Neg: She is not wearing a dress.

Que: Is she wearing a dress?

5) The teacher was writing on the whiteboard.

Neg: The teacher was not writing on the whiteboard.

Que: Was the teacher writing on the whiteboard?
