



Perfect continuous Form of Tense **Write Negative Sentences (Key)**

1) Have I been reading this book for hours?

Neg: *I have not been reading this book for hours.*

2) Will he have been practicing the piano all day?

Neg: *He will not have been practicing the piano all day.*

3) Had they been playing football for the entire afternoon?

Neg: *They had not been playing football for the entire afternoon.*

4) Had we been driving for hours before we reached our destination?

Neg: *We had not been driving for hours before we reached our destination.*

5) Had they been studying for the test all week?

Neg: *They had not been studying for the test all week.*

6) Had he been playing basketball since morning?

Neg: *He had not been playing basketball since morning.*

7) Had I been studying English for three months?

Neg: *I had not been studying English for three months.*

8) Had you been working on the project all day?

Neg: *You had not been working on the project all day.*

9) Had she been cooking dinner for the party all evening?

Neg: *She had not been cooking dinner for the party all evening.*

10) Had she been practicing the piano for hours?

Neg: *She had not been practicing the piano for hours.*
