Que: Are you studying for exams?

5) I have not been reading a book since morning.

Que: Have I been reading a book since morning?

6) Tom has not been working on his novel all weekend.

Que: Has Tom been working on his novel all weekend?

7) It is not raining heavily.

Que: Is it raining heavily?

8) She has not achieved her goals.

Que: Has she achieved her goals?
