Write Negative Sentences (Key)

1) Had you arrived before me?

Neg: You had not arrived before me.

2) Has it been a challenging task?

Neg: It has not been a challenging task.

3) Have they watched a movie?

Neg: They have not watched a movie.

4) Will we have organized the party?

Neg: We will not have organized the party.

5) Will you have improved your skills?

Neg: You will not have improved your skills.

6) Has he played the guitar?

Neg: He has not played the guitar.

7) Had the team won the championship?

Neg: The team had not won the championship.

8) Had Sarah finished her project before the deadline?

Neg: Sarah had not finished her project before the deadline.

9) Had he already left when I called him?

Neg: He had not already left when I called him.

10) Had he finished reading the book?

Neg: He had not finished reading the book.
