7) They will have been rehearsing for the play for weeks.

Que: Will they have been rehearsing for the play for weeks?

8) It will have been raining all day.

Que: Will it have been raining all day?

9) John will have been studying for the exam all night.

Que: Will John have been studying for the exam all night?

10) Sarah will have been working on her novel for months.

Que: Will Sarah have been working on her novel for months?
