**1)** Had Sarah been cooking dinner for the family for hours?

**Neg:** Sarah had not been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

**2)** Have I been working on this project all week?

**Neg:** I have not been working on this project all week.

---

**3)** Have the students been preparing for the presentation?

**Neg:** The students have not been preparing for the presentation.

---

**4)** Had we been traveling for hours before reaching the destination?

**Neg:** We had not been traveling for hours before reaching the destination.

---

**5)** Will John have been working as a teacher for five years?

**Neg:** John will not have been working as a teacher for five years.

---

**6)** Have you been working late every night this week?

**Neg:** You have not been working late every night this week.

---

**7)** Had I been studying for the exam all night?

**Neg:** I had not been studying for the exam all night.

---

**8)** Had I been working on this project for hours?

**Neg:** I had not been working on this project for hours.

---

**9)** Had she been baking cookies since this morning?

**Neg:** She had not been baking cookies since this morning.

---

**10)** Had Sarah been practicing her presentation all morning?

**Neg:** Sarah had not been practicing her presentation all morning.
