2) Have I been working on this project all week?

Pos: I have been working on this project all week.

3) Have the students been preparing for the presentation?

Pos: The students have been preparing for the presentation.

4) Had we been traveling for hours before reaching the destination?

Pos: We had been traveling for hours before reaching the destination.

5) Will John have been working as a teacher for five years?

Pos: John will have been working as a teacher for five years.

6) Have you been working late every night this week?

Pos: You have been working late every night this week.

7) Had I been studying for the exam all night?

Pos: I had been studying for the exam all night.

8) Had I been working on this project for hours?

Pos: I had been working on this project for hours.

9) Had she been baking cookies since this morning?

Pos: She had been baking cookies since this morning.
