Was I enjoying playing the piano?

- 3)** Does the cat meow when it's hungry?
Was the cat meowing when it was hungry?

- 4)** Does the bird sing a sweet melody?
Was the bird singing a sweet melody?

- 5)** Do you speak French fluently?
Were you speaking French fluently?

- 6)** Do we study for exams diligently?
Were we studying for exams diligently?

- 7)** Do we enjoy going to the movies?
Were we enjoying going to the movies?

- 8)** Do you love to read books?
Were you loving to read books?

- 9)** Do birds build nests in trees?
Were birds building nests in trees?

- 10)** Do dogs wag their tails when they're happy?
Were dogs wagging their tails when they were happy?
