

Change Negative Sentences

Simple Present to Past Perfect

- 1) The children do not play in the park.
The children had not played in the park.

- 2) I do not enjoy playing the piano.
I had not been enjoying playing the piano.

- 3) The cat does not meow when it's hungry.
The cat had not been meowing when it was hungry.

- 4) The bird does not sing a sweet melody.
The bird had not been singing a sweet melody.

- 5) You do not speak French fluently.
You had not been speaking French fluently.

- 6) We do not study for exams diligently.
We had not been studying for exams diligently.

- 7) We do not enjoy going to the movies.
We had not been enjoying going to the movies.

- 8) You do not love to read books.
You had not been loving to read books.

- 9) Birds do not build nests in trees.
Birds had not been building nests in trees.

- 10) Dogs do not wag their tails when they're happy.
Dogs had not been wagging their tails when they were happy.
