Simple Present to Past Perfect Continuous

- 1) Do we believe in the power of positivity?
Had we been believing in the power of positivity?

- 2) Do you brush your teeth twice a day?
Had you been brushing your teeth twice a day?

- 3) Do we exercise regularly?
Had we been exercising regularly?

- 4) Do you enjoy playing video games?
Had you been enjoying playing video games?

- 5) Does the river freeze in winter?
Had the river been freezing in winter?

- 6) Do they listen to podcasts during their commute?
Had they been listening to podcasts during their commute?

- 7) Does she enjoy going to concerts?
Had she been enjoying going to concerts?

- 8) Do you play guitar in a band?
Had you been playing guitar in a band?

- 9) Do we believe in fairy tales?
Had we been believing in fairy tales?

- 10) Does he drive a blue car?
Had he been driving a blue car?
