- 4) Does the bird sing a sweet melody?
Is the bird singing a sweet melody?

- 5) Do you speak French fluently?
Are you speaking French fluently?

- 6) Do we study for exams diligently?
Are we studying for exams diligently?

- 7) Do we enjoy going to the movies?
Are we enjoying going to the movies?

- 8) Do you love to read books?
Are you loving to read books?

- 9) Do birds build nests in trees?
Are birds building nests in trees?

- 10) Do dogs wag their tails when they're happy?
Are dogs wagging their tails when they're happy?
