Simple Present to Present Perfect

- 1)** Do the children play in the park?
Have the children played in the park?

- 2)** Do I enjoy playing the piano?
Have I been enjoying playing the piano?

- 3)** Does the cat meow when it's hungry?
Has the cat been meowing when it's hungry?

- 4)** Does the bird sing a sweet melody?
Has the bird been singing a sweet melody?

- 5)** Do you speak French fluently?
Have you been speaking French fluently?

- 6)** Do we study for exams diligently?
Have we been studying for exams diligently?

- 7)** Do we enjoy going to the movies?
Have we been enjoying going to the movies?

- 8)** Do you love to read books?
Have you been loving to read books?

- 9)** Do birds build nests in trees?
Have birds been building nests in trees?

- 10)** Do dogs wag their tails when they're happy?
Have dogs been wagging their tails when they're happy?
