Simple Present to Present Perfect Continuous

- 1)** The children do not play in the park.
The children have not been playing in the park.

- 2)** I do not enjoy playing the piano.
I have not enjoyed playing the piano.

- 3)** The cat does not meow when it's hungry.
The cat has not meowed when it's hungry.

- 4)** The bird does not sing a sweet melody.
The bird has not sung a sweet melody.

- 5)** You do not speak French fluently.
You have not spoken French fluently.

- 6)** We do not study for exams diligently.
We have not studied for exams diligently.

- 7)** We do not enjoy going to the movies.
We have not enjoyed going to the movies.

- 8)** You do not love to read books.
You have not loved to read books.

- 9)** Birds do not build nests in trees.
Birds have not built nests in trees.

- 10)** Dogs do not wag their tails when they're happy.
Dogs have not wagged their tails when they're happy.
