Simple Present to Present Perfect Continuous

1) They do not watch movies at the theater.
They have not been watching movies at the theater.

2) The cat does not scratch the furniture.
The cat has not been scratching the furniture.

3) You do not watch movies on weekends.
You have not been watching movies on weekends.

4) I do not wear glasses for reading.
I have not been wearing glasses for reading.

5) You do not take the bus to work.
You have not been taking the bus to work.

6) They do not eat healthy food.
They have not been eating healthy food.

7) You do not go swimming in the ocean.
You have not been going swimming in the ocean.

8) He does not brush his teeth before bed.
He has not been brushing his teeth before bed.

9) I do not eat vegetables for dinner.
I have not been eating vegetables for dinner.

10) We do not go for a walk in the park.
We have not been going for a walk in the park.
