3) Does the dog bark at strangers?

Has the dog barked at strangers?

4) Does my sister sing in a choir?

Has my sister sung in a choir?

5) Do the flowers need water every day?

Have the flowers needed water every day?

6) Does she work out at the gym?

Has she worked out at the gym?

7) Does the cat purr when it's happy?

Has the cat purred when it's happy?

8) Do you drink coffee in the morning?

Have you been drinking coffee in the morning?

9) Do they work hard to achieve their goals?

Have they been working hard to achieve their goals?

10) Do we have dinner together every night?

Have we been having dinner together every night?
