Simple Present to Present Perfect Continuous

- 1) Does he brush his hair in the morning?
Has he been brushing his hair in the morning?

- 2) Do the birds sing in the morning?
Have the birds been singing in the morning?

- 3) Do you play the violin with skill?
Have you been playing the violin with skill?

- 4) Do we listen to music while driving?
Have we been listening to music while driving?

- 5) Do we go for a bike ride on weekends?
Have we been going for a bike ride on weekends?

- 6) Do the birds chirp in the morning?
Have the birds been chirping in the morning?

- 7) Does he wear a red hat?
Has he been wearing a red hat?

- 8) Do my parents cook dinner at home?
Have my parents been cooking dinner at home?

- 9) Does she paint with vibrant colors?
Has she been painting with vibrant colors?

- 10) Does she dance at the ballet recital?
Has she been dancing at the ballet recital?
