Simple Present to Future Perfect Continuous

1) Does he brush his hair in the morning?
Will he have been brushing his hair in the morning?

2) Do the birds sing in the morning?
Will the birds have been singing in the morning?

3) Do you play the violin with skill?
Will you have been playing the violin with skill?

4) Do we listen to music while driving?
Will we have been listening to music while driving?

5) Do we go for a bike ride on weekends?
Will we have been going for a bike ride on weekends?

6) Do the birds chirp in the morning?
Will the birds have been chirping in the morning?

7) Does he wear a red hat?
Will he have been wearing a red hat?

8) Do my parents cook dinner at home?
Will my parents have been cooking dinner at home?

9) Does she paint with vibrant colors?
Will she have been painting with vibrant colors?

10) Does she dance at the ballet recital?
Will she have been dancing at the ballet recital?
